Our Denim & Diamonds Emcee

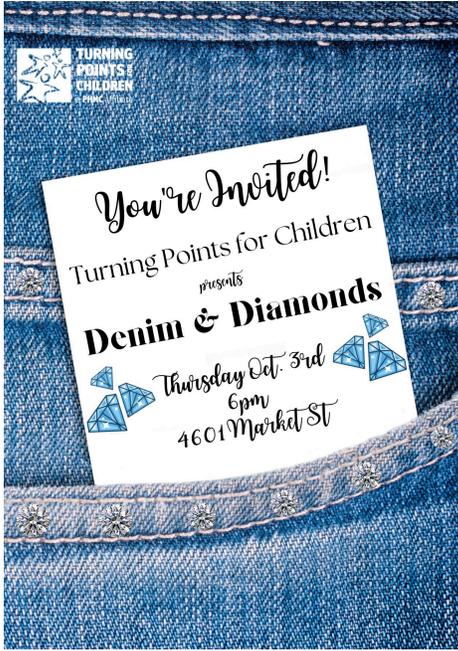
We are honored to have Keith Jones, Anchor, NBC10 News as our emcee for our Denim & Diamonds event! 💎
